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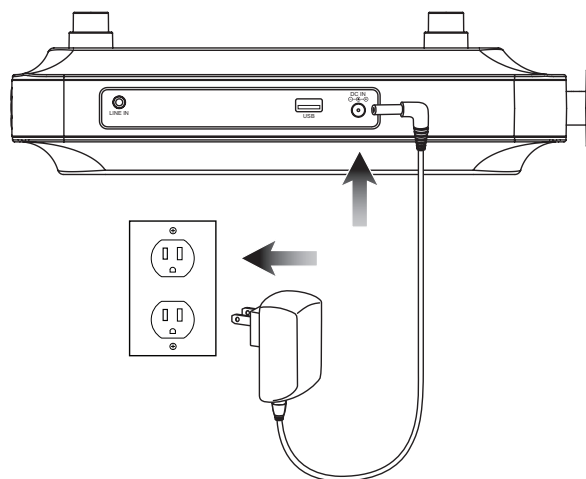

Power

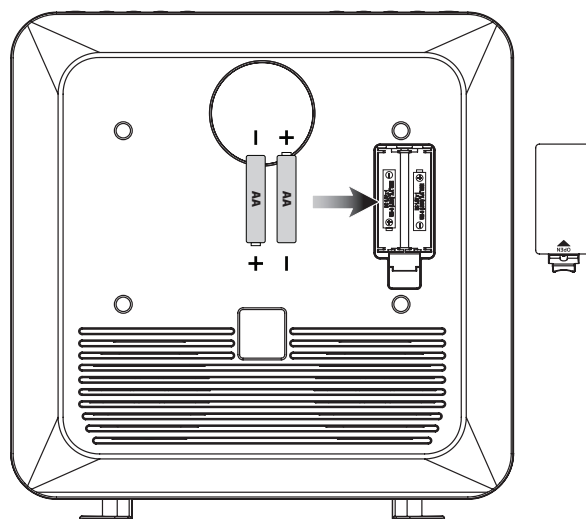
Connect the DC Power Adapter (included) into the DC Input on the under cabinet music system and a standard power outlet.



Battery Backup

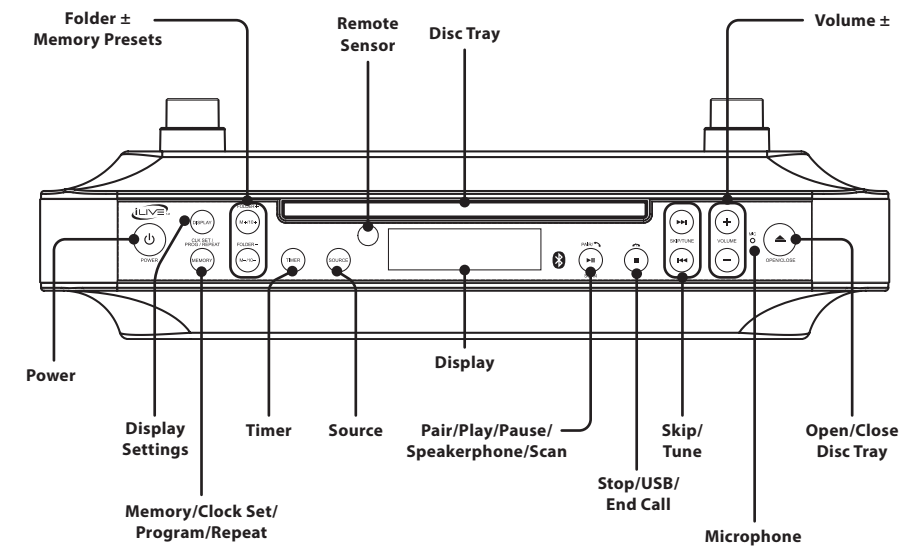
Requires: 2 AA-size, batteries (not included).

The battery backup is intended for short power outages only. The under cabinet music system's primary functions cannot run on the battery backup alone.

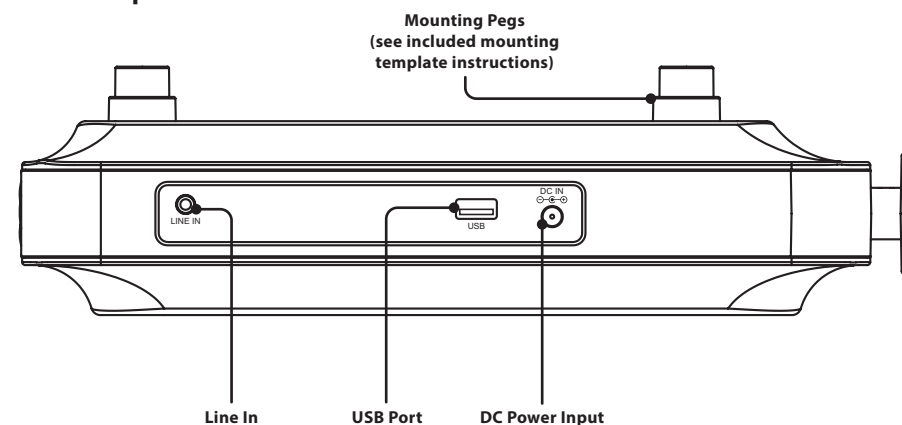


Orientation

Front Panel Controls

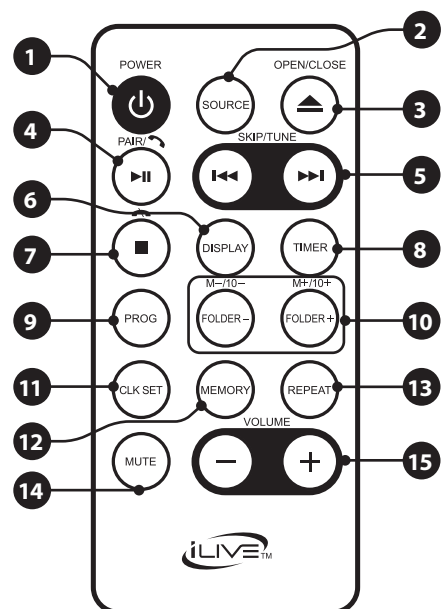

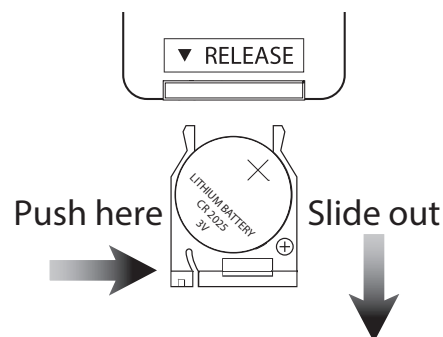

Remote Batteries

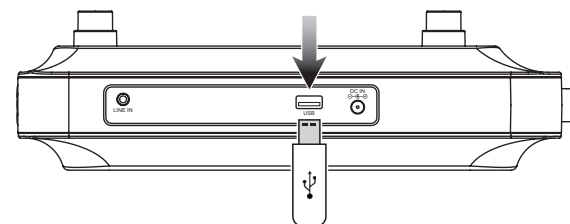
Requires 1 CR2025 button cell battery (included).



Connecting Devices

USB Drive

1. Load a USB drive into the USB Port (**32GB maximum**).
2. Press the **Source** button to switch to **USB Mode**. The display will show the total number of tracks on the USB drive.
3. Press the **Play/Pause** button to begin playing. Use the controls on the remote or the under cabinet music system to pause, adjust volume, etc.



Programming the USB Drive

The unit can be programmed to up to 99 tracks in the order you wish.

1. Please make sure the unit is stopped and in USB mode.
2. Press the **Prog** button, the Prog indicator will flash and the display will show "P01."
3. Press the **Skip/Tune** buttons to select the desired audio tracks. Press the **Prog** button to confirm the selection.
4. The display will advance to "P02," repeat step 3, up to a maximum of 99 tracks. When the maximum of 99 tracks have been programmed the display will read "FUL" to indicate the program list is full.
5. When you have completed programming, press the **Play/Pause** button to begin the program. The tracks will now play in the designated order. In order to cancel the programming press the **Stop** button twice.

USB Repeat Mode

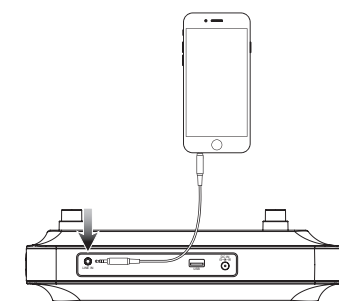
With the repeat feature you can choose to repeat one song, a folder or repeat all tracks.

1. To repeat a track press the **Repeat** button once. The display will show "↺ 1" indicating the unit will begin replaying the current track.
2. Press the **Repeat** button again to repeat a folder, the display will show "↺ FOLDER." **Note:** If there is no folder this function cannot be selected.
3. Press the **Repeat** button again to repeat all, the display will show "↺ ALL."
4. To cancel the repeat function, press the **Repeat** button until the repeat indicator on the display turns off.

Line In (3.5mm Audio Input)

Required: 3.5 mm audio input cable (not included).

1. Press the **Power** button to power on the under cabinet music system.
2. Connect a 3.5mm audio cable to the **Line In Input** on the side of the under cabinet music system and the **audio output/headphone jack** on an audio device.
3. Press the **Source** button to switch to **Line In Mode**.
4. Use the controls on the connected device to play your audio through the under cabinet music system.



Bluetooth Wireless

Pairing & Playing Audio

1. Press the **Power** button to power on the under cabinet music system.
2. Press the **Source** button to select **Bluetooth Mode**. The  **pairing indicator** on the display will begin flashing.
3. On your Bluetooth device, scan for and select **IKBC384SMP3U** in your Bluetooth settings to pair. *If your device requests a password, enter the default password 0 0 0 0. Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for instructions on pairing and connecting Bluetooth devices.*
When pairing, remain within 3 feet of the under cabinet music system.
4. When successfully paired, the voice prompt will say "Bluetooth connected." Use the controls on your connected device to select and begin playing audio.

After initial pairing, the unit will stay paired unless unpaired manually by the user or erased due to a reset of the device. If your device should become unpaired or you find it is unable to connect, press and hold the  **button** to manually enter into pairing mode. A voice prompt will say "Bluetooth is connecting," you can then connect manually.

Speakerphone

1. When a call is received, a ringtone will sound from the speaker.
2. Press the  button to accept the call, or accept the call using the controls on the connected phone.
3. The incoming call received through the device will now be heard through the speaker.
4. To end the call, press the  button or end the call using the controls on the connected phone.

CD Player

Loading and Playing a CD

Note: This unit is compatible with MP3 CDs.

1. Press the **Power** button to power on the under cabinet music system.
2. Press the **Source** button to select **CD**.
3. Press the **Open/Close** button to open the Disc Tray and place a disc into the tray, label side facing up.
4. Press the **Open/Close** button to close the disc tray. The display will show the total number of tracks on the CD after a few seconds.
5. Press the **Play/Pause** button to start playing.
6. Use the controls on the remote or the under cabinet music system to pause, adjust volume, etc.

Programming a CD

Note: Please make sure the unit is stopped and in CD mode when trying to program.

1. While in CD mode, press the **Prog** button. The display will show "P01"
2. Use the **Skip/Tune** buttons to select the desired audio track. Press the **Prog** button to confirm selection.
3. The display will advance to "P02" repeat step 2 to program up to 20 tracks (99, if using a MP3 CD).
4. When the maximum number of tracks are programmed the display will read "FUL" to indicate the program list is full.
5. When you have completed programming, press the **Play/Pause** button to begin the program. Audio tracks will now play in the designated order.
6. To cancel a program, press the **Stop** button twice.

CD Repeat Mode

With the repeat feature you can choose to repeat one song, a folder or repeat all tracks.

1. To repeat a track press the **Repeat** button once. The display will show " 1" indicating the unit will begin replaying the current track.
2. Press the **Repeat** button again to repeat a folder, the display will show " **FOLDER.** " **Note:** If there is no folder this function cannot be selected.
3. Press the **Repeat** button again to repeat all, the display will show " **ALL.** "
4. To cancel the repeat function, press the **Repeat** button until the repeat indicator on the display turns off.

FM Radio

Radio Reception

An FM receiver is built into the under cabinet music system. To improve radio reception, adjust the position of the unit.

Tuning the FM Radio

1. Press the **Power** button to power on the under cabinet music system.
2. Press the **Source** button to switch to **FM Radio Mode**.
3. Press the **Skip/Tune** buttons to tune the radio manually. Press and hold the **Skip/Tune** button to scan for available stations.

Automatically Saving Radio Station Presets

1. Press the **Scan** button, the under cabinet music system will scan available FM radio frequencies and save them as a memory preset (P01, P02, etc.).
2. Once saved, press the **M +/-** buttons to cycle through preset radio stations.

Manually Saving Radio Stations Presets

1. Tune to the desired station.
2. Press the **Memory** button, the preset number will appear on the display (P01, P02, etc.).
3. Press the **M +/-** buttons to adjust to the desired preset number.
4. Press the **Memory** button to save the radio station to the preset.
5. Press the **M +/-** buttons to cycle through preset radio stations.

Clock & Timer

Setting the Clock

1. With the power off, press and hold the **Clk Set** button. The hour on the display will begin flashing.
2. Press the **Skip/Tune** buttons to set the hour.
3. Press the **Clk Set** button again, the minutes on the display will begin flashing.
4. Press the **Skip/Tune** buttons to set the minutes.
5. Press the **Clk Set** button to finish setting the time, or wait for the display to stop flashing.

Using the Timer

1. Press the **Timer** button to adjust the timer (180-0 min) in increments of 10.
2. Wait for the display to stop flashing. The **Timer** indicator will appear on the display and countdown the minutes.
3. After the set time has expired, the under cabinet music system will sound an alarm.
 - To cancel the alarm after it has sounded, press the **Power** button.
 - To cancel the timer before the alarm has sounded, press the **Timer** button until the display reads **00** and the timer light is no longer lit.
